RULES AND INFORMATION

PARADE

Parade begins at 11:00 a.m. Vehicles will be worked in the parade by parade officials. Parade route will head south on Titus Street to square, and circle around to Tyler and continue west to Trinity Street, follow Trinity St. until it ends at Walnut St. and go left on Walnut then go an additional 50 ft. to Railroad St. Take a right on Railroad St which leads to the float barn area. Car show will be officially over after the parade, but you may park and exhibit your vehicle in staging area after the parade.

Parade Rules:

1. Vehicles must proceed at a slow pace, following the movement of the parade entries.
2. Vehicles must drive in a straight line. No weaving.
3. Absolutely no burnouts or excessive engine revving.
4. Vehicles will be worked in parade by parade officials, approximately 4-5 at a time.
5. Any violation of parade rules will result in removal of vehicle from parade.
6. No CD's or radios from cars.
7. **ENTRIES MAY NOT THROW OR PASS OUT CANDY OR ANY OTHER ITEM, INCLUDING TRINKETS OR FLIERS.**
